EXTRA-TERRITORIAL REACH OF US TAXATION

I am writing on behalf of citizens and residents from my electorate who are also citizens of the United States and are concerned about the increasing burden they are facing due to extra-territorial taxation from the United States.

As I understand it, current drafts of *The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act* in the United States could potentially allow the Internal Revenue Service of the US Government to collect a significant proportion of retained earnings of small Australian corporations controlled by Australian-US dual citizens. This would be in addition to the existing double-taxation challenges already faced by US citizens who are Australian residents or citizens.

For further context, I have enclosed a copy of a letter to the Prime Minister supplied to me by advocates from 'Let's Fix the Tax Treaty!' * .

Can you please kindly advise how the Australian Government intends to address and minimise this potential concern created by *The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act?*

Can you also please advise what arrangements the Federal Government has in place to reduce the burden of double-taxation faced by US citizens who are Australian citizens or residents?
